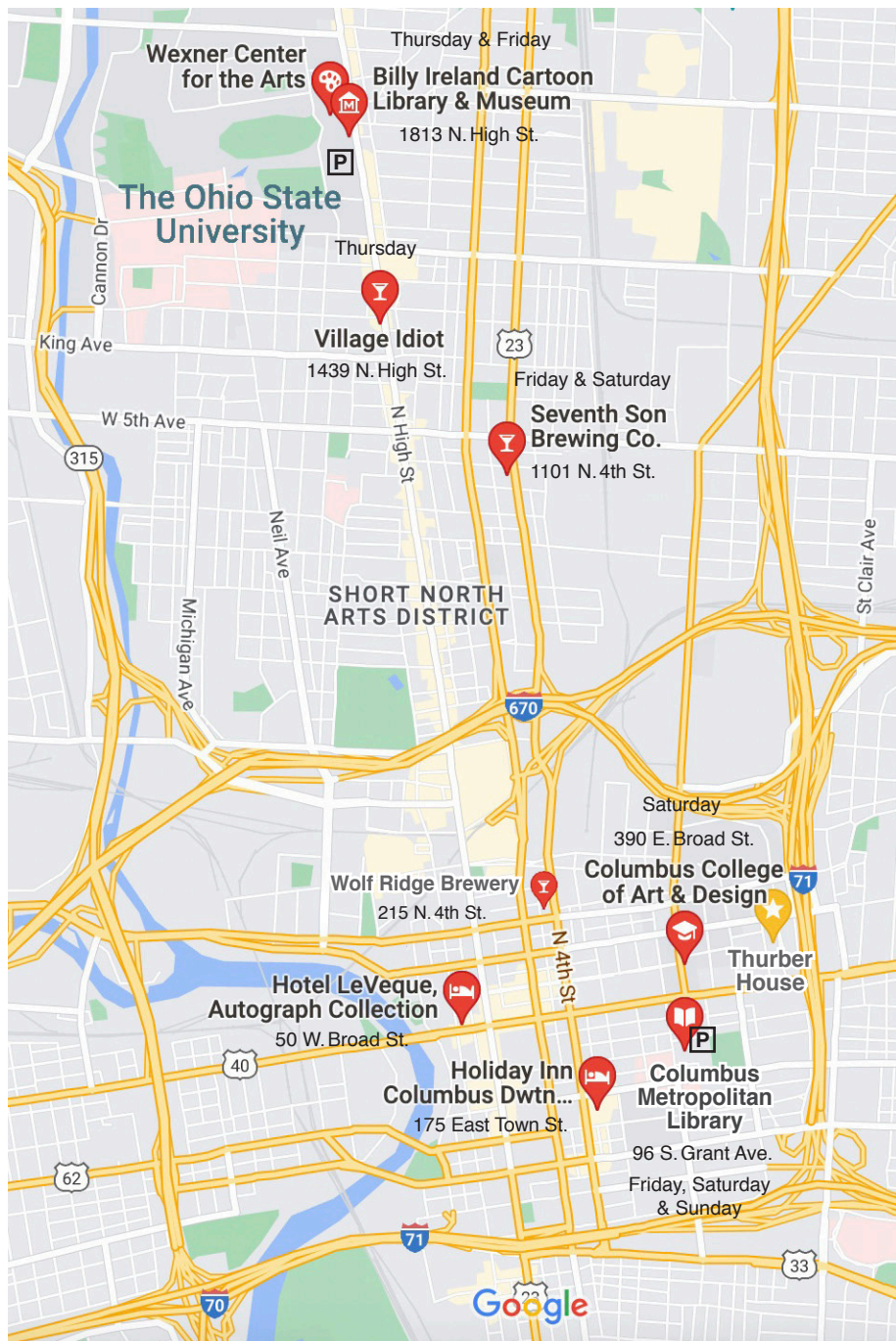


## 2022 AAEC/CXC FESTIVAL LOCATIONS

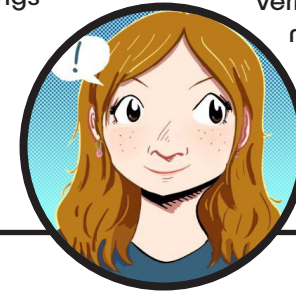
### AAEC PRESENTS:
